

Educational Student Plans

Teachers will be responsible for approximately 20 students and will act as their advisor in addition to class room instructor. A file will be prepared for each student and the following information will be obtained through meetings with the students and parents at least twice a year. The individual student plan is a step by step process where educators gather knowledge about a student=s interests, learning styles, and personal history to use in designing learning experiences.

This process of exploration and discovery involves not only developing a relationship with the student, but also with the student=s family. Through the process, an educator gathers information about a student=s progress and learning style, guiding the student to success and enabling him/her to meet academic standards. The following list will include but not be limited to the information each teacher/advisor will keep for the student:

- X strengths and talents
- X learning history
- X family history and makeup
- X learning style
- X academic background
- X standardized testing history
- X preferred learning environment
- X life experiences
- X developmental accomplishments
- X interests, aspirations, and motivations
- X areas for growth in academic, social, emotional, and physical realms.

The plan will be established and re-evaluated at meeting to be held throughout the year with students, parents, and teachers.

Advisors to 8th - 12th grade students will oversee the students in the development of their resume and college application essay.
